## Upcoming Events Fall Semester 2024 - Local School Engagements

Haley & Aldrich is looking for volunteers to help with some events we're programming this fall with our neighbors at Bunker Hill Community College (BHCC), UMass Boston (UMB), and select Boston Public School (BPS) high schools. The purpose is to expose students to the broad array of careers in the Architecture, Engineering, and Construction industry, and convince them there's something for nearly everyone. We are working to bring more diversity to the AEC industry pipeline, and at least for our firm, in hopes that our staff profile better reflects the communities we serve!

BHCC is a two-year (junior) college that offers associate degrees and transfer options to a four-year college. UMB is a four-year program with varying majors. Both colleges are federally defined as Minority-Serving Institutions (MSIs). BPS schools often have career pathways tracks but look different from school to school, and we adapt to their needs. Formats/Logistics with colleges are also different than high schools. Regardless, our large-format events are meant to provide broad industry-wide exposure, and the smaller in-class events are discipline-specific to provide exposure at greater depth (e.g., engineering, business, or visual arts focus).

<b>Careers Poster Session</b> <b>(FULL)</b>	BHCC	9/24, ~11:00-2:00	Think "reverse career fair." This is a session where students can explore different AEC career disciplines and ask you questions about what you do and how you got there. The focus for this event is to showcase a cross-section of our industry, not primarily trying to hire candidates to your specific company.  We are looking for poster-presenters from every AEC discipline to share what it's like to work in that particular field. <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• H&amp;A will provide a template for the poster, which will include suggested key sections to exhibit. The posters will focus on your personal journey, what someone in your discipline does on a day-to-day, and potential career paths for students at your firm. We are looking for lots of graphics and photos to spark conversations.</li><li>• There will be two virtual prep meetings to provide more guidance and details about the poster creation and final logistics.</li></ul> We also need volunteers to provide general support (registration table, help with setup/breakdown, food, networking, etc.)

Field Trip to a Development/ Construction Site – South Station Tower <b>(FULL)</b>	UMB	11/1, 3:00-5:00	<p>South Station Tower</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>In conjunction with Haley &amp; Aldrich and those familiar with the host site, we are looking for PWC volunteers from different disciplines to help facilitate questions and share their discipline-specific knowledge with students as we break up into tour groups of varying interest. There are generally two ways in which we need help.</li> <li><b>Tour Guide/Support:</b> You don't have to be an "expert" in your field! You will be able to share your experience and perspective even with less years on the job. At the event, you will be paired with someone knowledgeable about the project and our expectation of you is to be converse with your student group (matched by career interest) to walk the tour and chime in to share your general development/construction knowledge, and be an interpreter!</li> <li><b>General Support:</b> We could also use volunteers to provide general support (registration table, help with setup/breakdown, food, student networking, etc.)</li> </ul> <p>Note: There will be a virtual preparation meeting before the tour to review logistics and expectations.</p>

<b>Classroom/Club Visits</b>	Various	Oct/Nov	We have regular requests from HS teachers and college professors of varying departments to have a short “Day in the Life” presentation with lots of Q&A. Often paired with H&A staff for familiarity/logistical navigation.
